



Iron Butt Association - Guidelines for the Benelux 4 Corners Ride

This IBA special ride is partly designed by Martien Kramer.

The 4 Corners of the Benelux takes you to the most northerly, southerly, westerly and the geographical centres of the Netherlands, Belgian and Luxembourg.

Please note:

You can ride this as a Special Ride without any time and distance requirements or combine it with a classic IBA ride of your choice as an IBA Ride Plus. This ride is a very demanding ride due to its complexity and its high proportion of two-lane national roads, **therefore this IBA Ride Plus ride is for existing IBA MEMBERS ONLY.**

In addition to the general IBA Ride Guidelines, the following **specific rules** apply to the BNLX4C:

In addition to the usual **filling station** receipts, the ride must be **documented** with photographs of your **motorbike** taken at the **following locations**:

- Most **northern point** of the Netherlands
- Most **northwest point** of the Netherlands
- Most eastern point of the Netherlands
- Most western point of the Netherlands
- Most southern point of Netherlands
- Most western point of Belgian
- Most northern point of Belgian
- Most southern point of Belgian
- Most eastern point of Belgian
- Most southern point in Luxembourg
- The geographical **Centre** of the Netherlands
- The geographical **Centre** of Belgian
- The geographical **Centre** of Luxemburg

You also need to obtain **filling station receipts** from these **four cities in the Benelux** (as close as possible to the point for the photo location, to be checked according the address on the receipt):

- Den Helder
- Lunteren
- Miersch
- Walhain

Benelux 4 Corners Ride GOLD

There is an opportunity to make this Benelux 4 Corners an IBA Special GOLD ride. For this you have to walk to some points and take a **selfie** at that specific location.

- Northern point: take a selfie at the Nord Kapp near Hogeland-Eemshaven
- Center of Netherlands: take a selfie at the big stone in the woods
- Western point: take a selfie at the mark in the dunes near Bray-Dunes
- Most southern point Belgian: take a selfie at the landmark in the open field
- Geographical center Luxemburg: take a selfie at the landmark

Note: In Hoogstraten, at the northernmost point of Belgium, you need a photo of the sign in the garden of the house at number 41. Try to get this sign in the picture together with your motorcycle and yourself.

Please note: the mentioned time for walking is from the point you can park your motorcycle and walk to the land mark.

Furthermore, the following should be **noted**:

This ride is a very demanding ride due to its complexity and its high proportion of country roads.

Therefore - this ride is for IBA MEMBERS ONLY.

Like every IBA-Ride the BNLX4C starts and ends with a filling station receipt.

If you are planning to ride with pillion - the pillion must be on all photos. All locations must be photographed as described and be clearly visible.

All photos should be in jpeg format, the resolution should be not higher than 1920 x 1080.

Please make sure before the start of the Ride that the date and time of the camera are set correctly.

You can start your ride anywhere and include the 4 Corners of the Benelux in this ride. A fuel receipt at the start and end of the ride does not have to be from the same station.

Plan carefully and keep the rules and you will have this ride always in good memory.
