



Iron Butt Association – Ludwig von Beethoven Ride

The BTHVN is a special ride on the 250th anniversary of the birth of Ludwig van Beethoven (17.12.1770 - 26.06.1827).

You will visit the birthplace of Ludwig van Beethoven in Bonngasse 20 in 53111 Bonn, as well as his final resting place.

His grave is located at the Vienna Central Cemetery - Tor 2, Group 32 A, Simmeringer Hauptstraße 234 in 1110 Vienna.

The BTHVN must be combined with an IBA ride of your choice.

The BTHVN may also be ridden by Non IBA member e.g. as **SS1600K - BTHVN** to get an IBA number.

In addition to the general IBA guidelines in the currently published version, the following special rules apply to the BTHVN:

Photos of the birthplace and of Ludwig's grave are required in addition to the tank receipts.

You can start and finish your ride at any gas station you like, as well as plan and ride in any order (Bonn / Vienna).

Please note:

Depending on how you plan your route and which IBA-Ride you choose, you might have to drive the missing kilometers before you get your final fuel receipt !

Like every IBA ride the BTHVN starts and ends with a typewritten fuel receipt.

The photo points must be clearly visible. For rides with a pillion rider this must be on both photos.
